This, it is needless for me to add, should be done under the strictest aseptic and antiseptic precautions. Nephrorrhaphy or suturing the kidney to the structures around it should be done, the patient should be thoroughly purged and the surface rendered aseptic by washing it with green soap, then ether, then a bichloride solution of 1 to 1000. He should be placed with the face downward, inclined to the side and an incision made two and one-half to three inches from the vertebral spines and parallel to them; beginning one-half an inch to one inch below the twelfth rib and extending to near the iliac crest, cut down through the tissues to the capsule of the kidney. Some surgeons advise dividing this and stitching the edges to either side...
