F. A. Walker, therein mentioned and subsequently received, I held a council, and entered into a convention with the Shoshone Indians of Wyoming Territory, for the relinquishment of a part of their reservation as contemplated by the act of Congress approved June 1, 1872, and make the following report: I left Bryan Station, on the Union Pacific Railroad, on the 11th of September, accompanied by Thomas K. Cree, esq., secretary of the Board of Indian Commissioners, and arriving at South Pass City on the evening of the 12th, reached the Shoshone and Bannock agency, in Little Wind River Valley, on the 14th. The road to South Pass City crosses Green River, Big Sandy, Dry Sandy, and Pacific Springs, passing through a country of...
